



Trustee Vacancies

Stepping Stones is an award-winning charity based in Luton which meets the needs of vulnerable women and their children. Practitioners deliver community-based, frontline support to women impacted by domestic abuse, in contact with the criminal justice system, struggling with drug addiction or substance abuse, and those who have offended. Services include women's group programmes, One-to-One support and counselling, and the provision of an Ofsted approved childcare facility.

We are currently looking for new trustees for the Stepping Stones Board and are particularly interested in hearing from people with a background in fundraising or marketing. Candidates from ethnic minority backgrounds are especially welcome to help reflect both our diverse work force and service users. As a women-only safe space roles are usually open to women only, however, our trustee vacancies are open to both men and women.

Our current trustees bring a range of skills and experience to the Board. They share their expertise to oversee the development and implementation of our strategic and business plans, and the charity's finances.

The Board currently meets four times per year with in-person meetings in the evening in our Luton office. Any ad hoc issues which may arise are dealt with by email correspondence or online meetings
